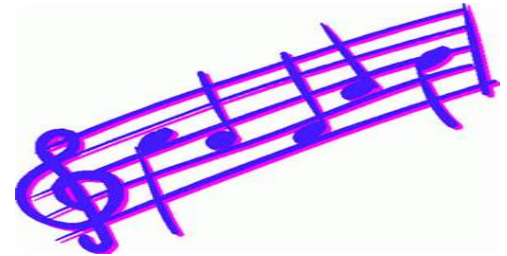


1960s Hit Songs Renamed for Seniors
