Recipe for a Bug-Free Summer

Blend a batch of this all-natural spray developed by Amanda Blake Soule, author of *The Rhythm of Family*.

3½ oz. witch hazel
½ tsp. lemongrass oil
½ tsp eucalyptus oil
½ tsp citronella oil

Combine all ingredients in a four-ounce spray bottle.

We are Coming into Fruit Fly Season
To get rid of these pests.....

Put 2 – 3 drops of liquid dish soap into a small glass (a shot glass works well), and fill 2/3 full with Apple Cider Vinegar. The vinegar attracts them & the soap keeps them from escaping the glass.
