## Remember!!!

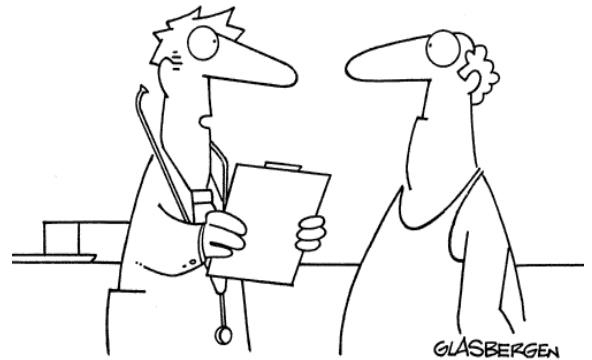
Now that it is getting warmer out, our neighbors & friends will be out walking.

Why lemon juice is made with artificial flavor and dish washing liquid made with real lemons?

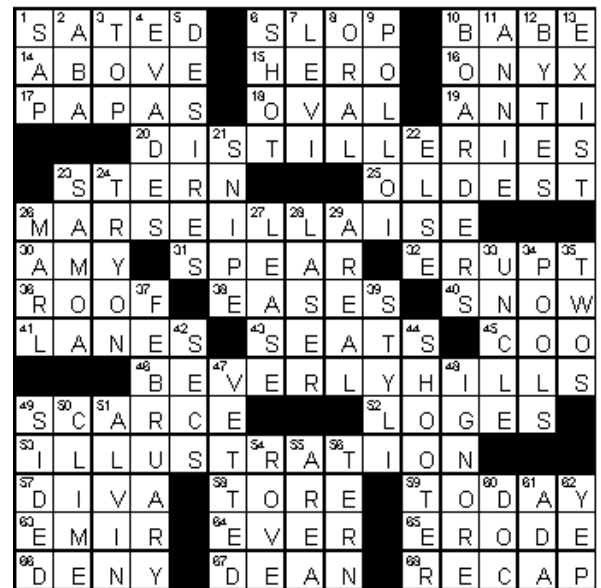
Why they call the airport the terminal if flying is so safe?
