**Quirky Phrase**  
**"Chairman of the Board"**

In the late 1700's many houses consisted of a large room with only one chair. Commonly, a long wide board was folded down from the wall and used for dining. The head of the household or an important guest always sat in a chair at the head of this board. To sit in the chair meant you were important and in charge and this position was called "chair man". Today, we use the expression "Chairman" or "Chairman of the Board".
