The winter snow season is coming soon. During a snow storm all resident vehicles must be off the street. It takes 2 to 3 hrs to clean the roads depending on the storm.... If you don't want to be dug out by outsiders at six in the morning put a sign on your door **NO SHOVEL**. Then remove the sign if you want to be dug out.

With cold weather approaching, be sure to disconnect your garden hose from the outside faucet. If the faucet seems loose on its mount, tip it down to let the water drain out. This will prevent it from freezing. Be sure to have your sprinkler system winterized as well. All sprinkler Systems must be turned off by Oct 15 2015

If you want to cover your air conditoner, be sure to leave an open space on the sides to allow for air circulation. This prevents the moisture from building up inside the condenser. This moisture can damage electric controls in the condenser unit. Most manufactures do not recommend covering the condenser for this reason. If you do cover the outside condenser unit, please consult your manual

We awarded the bid on the paving of the entrance and other areas in the community. We had to deny the contractor due to insurance issues on the part of the contractor. We are working with another contactor to get the paving done.
