



CPR/AED TRAINING

A life saving training course (Bystander CPR) has been brought to Foxwood Village by four of our very own community members including; Bill and Margaret Fortunato, Cathy Hannon and Denis Joyce. Bill is a certified Basic Life Support Instructor with the American Heart Association.

The training includes chest compressions only CPR, no rescue breaths, and use of an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) training device that replicates the units available at the club house and pool side.

Bystander CPR skills are a significant benefit, and added insurance, to family, friends and community members. Trained individuals provide a ready reserve of available competent rescuers to assist others experiencing a cardio vascular emergency occurrence.

To date, five Bystander CPR courses have been implemented to train forty community members. A sixth class will be offered December 1, 2015. Nine additional individuals are preregistered.

Congratulations are in order for our forty community members who successfully completed the important life saving Bystander CPR course. Moreover, our thanks go out to the Foxwood Village Management and HOA Leadership for their support. Special thanks go out to our Bystander CPR Training Team.

Additional Bystander CPR courses will be conducted in the spring of 2016 at no cost to attendees. Each class is implemented at the club house. Class duration is approximately three hours.
