Selling your Home?

- When Foxwood Village Sales is not the listing broker, a \$500.00 closing fee will be assessed as our staff must still process paperwork at the closing
- It is important to recognize that a home sale in a land lease community is different than a traditional real estate sale, and many outside brokers are not familiar with the process. Our staff are experts in these type of transactions and can handle the sale of your home in a smooth and efficient manner.

Caffeine in Coffee

According to the Doka Coffee Plantation located in Costa Rica the amount of caffeine in the darkest roast coffee (Espresso) is no higher than their breakfast blend. The belief that the dark roasts have more caffeine is a common misconception caused by the stronger taste.

Stronger tasting coffee has been roasted 3 times longer than breakfast blends. It can also be because a better bean has been used.

Robusta and Arabica are the 2 types of beans grown. Arabica are the higher grade and more expensive because of the delicate nature. They are susceptible to disease.

Robusta beans are hearty and disease resistant and have more caffeine and less sugar but are not the top quality.

Picking less than full ripe beans can lower the quality of the coffee.

Bottom line: while a coffee may taste stronger it is not higher in caffeine and won't rev you up. **Decaffeinated Coffee:** The Germans are one of the biggest removers of caffeine because they have a non chemical process. They do it with water. It is done for the coffee growers for little to no cost. The growers in turn sell the caffeine to companies like Coca Cola, Pepsi and candy makers.

If the coffee is decaffeinated by water it usually will say it on the package. No company will say it was done with chemicals on the package.

FYI:

Americans love chicken and eat an average of 92 pounds per person of the bird each year. Chicken is high in protein, low in fat and rich in nutrients including iron, zinc and vitamin B. By 1985, people were eating more chicken than pork for the first time in American history. By 1992, domestic chicken consumption surpassed beef consumption.

According to the USDA, the retail price of beef today averages about \$5.70 a pound, while chicken averages \$1.85 a pound.

Chickens are the closest living relatives of the Tyrannosaurus Rex.

The United States has more than 3,200 restaurants dedicated primarily to chicken wings.

Basic Chicken Stock:

8 pounds chicken legs, backs and/or wings

1 carrot, trimmed

1 onion, peeled

1 parsnip, trimmed

1 bunch dill or parsley

7 quarts water

Salt

Ground pepper

- 1. Combine the chicken, carrots, parsnip, onion and dill or parsley in a 12 quart stock pot. Bring to a boil. Lower the heat to a simmer and cook, using a skimmer to remove any gray foam that rises to the surface. Simmer for 4 hours.
- 2. Place a smaller stockpot in your sink and place a fine mesh strainer in the stockpot. Carefully pour hot stock through strainer and into pot, pressing down on the chicken and vegetables. Discard the solids. Stir in salt and pepper to taste. Refrigerate for up to 3 days and skim the fat from the top of the pot before using. Alternatively, freeze the stock in large or 2 small containers until ready to use. Makes about 4 quarts.

Once you've made chicken stock, you can use it to make a variety of chicken soups.

MATZO ball soup: warm 2 quarts stock: make matzo balls according to directions on a package of matzo meal and add to warm stock along with handfuls of baby carrots. Before serving, simmer until the carrots are softened, about 10 minutes.

ITALIAN wedding soup: Brown small meatballs on all sides and add to 1quart simmering stock along with 1/2 cup small pasta (orzo, pastina). Simmer until meatballs and pasta are cooked through, about 10 minutes.

Stir in 8 baby spinach (or baby kale) leaves and cook stirring, until wilted. Serve with grated Parmesan cheese the side.
