

RESIDENT OF THE MONTH Betty Terkuile #71

My father, Archibald Tesseyman, was an airplane mechanic with the 213th squadron. (World War I).

He was aboard the "Tuscania" when it was torpedoed and sunk. He took a chance and ran below deck & took his overcoat; it went with him to the lifeboats. One of the men slipped getting into the lifeboat. The men pulled him in but he was wet and freezing. My father gave him his overcoat & later Alvin Samuels said that my father saved his life. Eventually the men went to Ayr, Scotland, the British flyers and crews started off there. My mother, whose brother had been killed, enlisted and was on the field as part of the British air force, repairing the torn linen on their planes. It was then that my parents met.

In due time, my father went to France with his squadron. When turning the blades of a propeller for one of the planes, both of his arms were broken and one leg gashed because the pilot forgot to say "contact".

Eventually he recovered and returned to duty, then returned home with the squadron. My mother was discharged from her group at the end of the war. They became pen pals, eventually "love pals" and Archie asked Jean if she would come to the US and become his wife. She said "yes", came here and they were married and lived in Astoria for a few years near Archie's' brothers and their families. Archie enjoyed artwork and was employed by the Eastern Terracotta Company where he became an architectural draftsman.

Approximately 1926 Jean, Archie and little Betty moved out to Rosedale on the South shore of Long Island – all farmland at that time with a tiny airfield further east called Greenacres. When Betty was about 6 years old, she and Dad walked along Merrick Road West to the local cigar-candy store. Another young man about Archie's age came in and looked at my father and exclaimed "you saved my life!" it was Alvin Samuels to whom Archie had given his overcoat in the Tuscania lifeboat. Mr. Samuels and his family lived in Laurelton. It was quite a reunion and he insisted on giving me (the closest thing he could) a little stuffed toy bulldog which I kept for many years.

Two brave veterans.

Caffeine in Coffee

According to the Doka Coffee Plantation located in Costa Rica the amount of caffeine in the darkest roast coffee (Espresso) is no higher than their breakfast blend. The belief that the dark roasts have more caffeine is a common misconception caused by the stronger taste.

Stronger tasting coffee has been roasted 3 times longer than breakfast blends. It can also be because a better bean has been used.

Robusta and Arabica are the 2 types of beans grown. Arabica are the higher grade and more expensive because of the delicate nature. They are susceptible to disease.

Robusta beans are hearty and disease resistant and have more caffeine and less sugar but are not the top quality.

Picking less than full ripe beans can lower the quality of the coffee.

Bottom line: while a coffee may taste stronger it is not higher in caffeine and won't rev you up.

Decaffeinated Coffee: The Germans are one of the biggest removers of caffeine because they have a non chemical process. They do it with water. It is done for the coffee growers for little to no cost. The growers in turn sell the caffeine to companies like Coca Cola, Pepsi and candy makers.

If the coffee is decaffeinated by water it usually will say it on the package. No company will say it was done with chemicals on the package.

Cooks' Corner

What's In Season? Artichokes are the surest sign of spring.

How to clean an artichoke for stuffing:

Cut off artichoke stem at the bottom so it can easily stand on your work surface. Cut about an inch or more off the top while holding it against the work surface with your other hand.

Hallow out the center with a melon baller or spoon. Make sure you go almost all the way to the bottom. Also, pull out the hairy choke and discard.

STUFFED ARTICHOKES:

6 medium artichokes, 1/2 lemon, 2 cups bread crumbs, 3/4 cup grated Parmesan cheese, 1/3 cup chopped parsley, 2 cloves garlic, chopped, salt and pepper, 6 tablespoons olive oil

- 1. Wash the artichokes and allow to dry upside down to drain.
- 2. Remove the tough outer leaves at the base and cut about 1/2" off the tips of the remaining leaves.
- 3. With a sharp knife, slice the top of the artichokes straight across, taking off about 1".
- 4. As you trim, rub the artichokes with a lemon to prevent discoloration.
- 5. Tap them, firmly on a hard surface to force the center leaves slightly open.
- 6. Combine the bread crumbs, cheese, parsley and garlic.
- 7. Blend well and season with salt and pepper.
- 8. Distribute the filling among the 6 artichokes, placing some in the center and tucking some between the spread leaves.
- 9. Close the leaves gently and arrange the artichokes closely together in a baking pan.
- 10. Pour 1 tbsp of oil over each. Add 1 cup of water to the bottom of the pan.

COOKING METHODS:

Cover tightly with aluminum foil and bake in a 325 F oven, basting occasionally, for about 1 hour 45 minutes, or until the leaves pull out easily. Add water if necessary to maintain a little liquid in the pan. Or, which I prefer to do, fill a pot that can hold a steamer basket to one fourth capacity with water. Place the artichokes, around the basket. Steam until artichoke leaves soften or until leaves pull out easily.

Serves 6.
