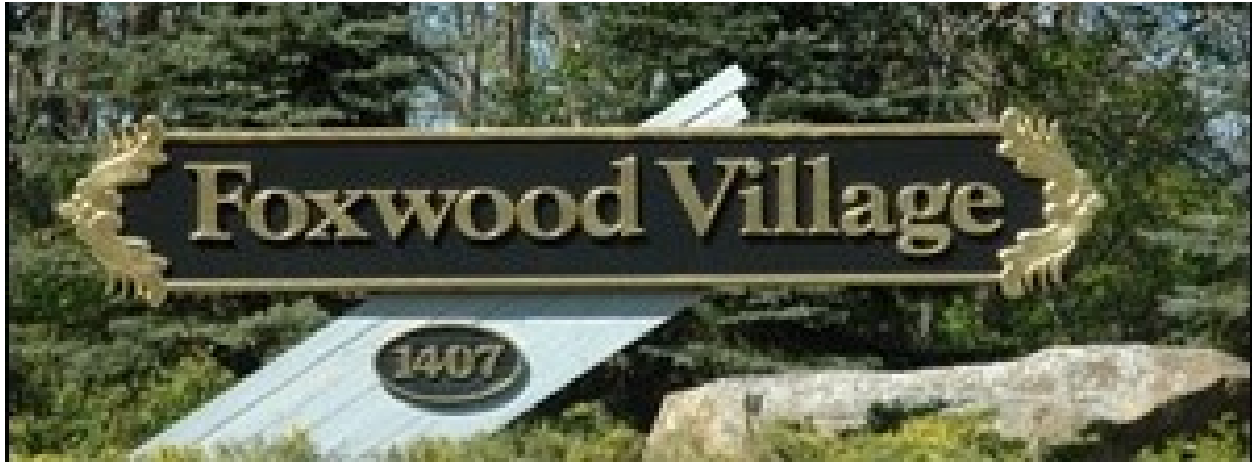

Selling your Home?

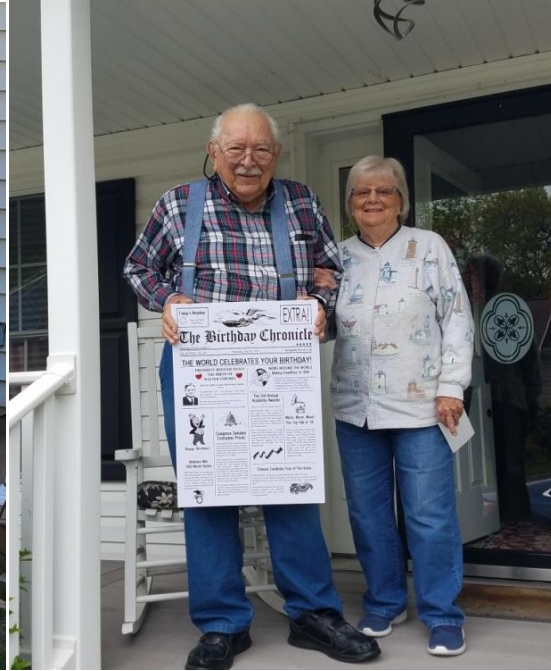

Cooks' Corner

It's that time of year again to enjoy outside eating and grilling.

BARBECUE CHICKEN:

2 broiler/fryer chickens (3 to 4pounds each) , cut into 8pieces each. Salt and pepper.

Barbecue Sauce:

2 tablespoons canola oil. 2 small onions, finely chopped. 2 cups of ketchup. 1/4 cup lemon juice. 2 tablespoons brown sugar. 2 tablespoons of water. 1 teaspoon ground mustard. 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder. 1/4 teaspoon pepper. 1/8 teaspoon salt. 1/8 teaspoon hot pepper sauce.

1. Sprinkle chicken pieces with salt and pepper. grill skin side down, uncovered, on a greased grill side down, uncovered, on a greased grill rack over medium heat for 20 minutes.

2. Meanwhile, in a small saucepan, make barbecue sauce by heating oil over medium heat. Add onions, sauté until tender. Stir in remaining sauce ingredients and bring to a boil. Reduce the heat; simmer, uncovered, for 10 minutes.

3. Turn chicken, brush with barbecue sauce. Grill 15-25 minutes longer, brushing frequently with sauce, until a thermometer reads 165% when inserted in the breast and 170-175% in the thigh.

ENJOY!

The following salad is a tasty dish for a barbecue.

BACON PEA SALAD:

4 cups frozen peas(about 16 ounces),thawed. 1/2 cup shredded sharp cheddar cheese. 1/2 cup ranch salad dressing .1/3 cup chopped red onion. 1/3 teaspoon of salt. 1/4 teaspoon of pepper. 4 bacon strips, cooked and crumbled.

Combine the first six ingredients; toss to coat. Refrigerate, covered, for at least 30 minutes. Stir in the bacon before serving.
