### **Selling your Home?**

- It is important to recognize that a home sale in a land lease community is different than a traditional real estate sale, and many outside brokers are not familiar with the process. Our staff are experts in these type of transactions and can handle the sale of your home in a smooth and efficient manner.

**Resolution 2020-338**  
**RESOLUTION WATER USE RESTRICTION**

On July 7, 2020 the Riverhead Town Board adopted Resolution 2020-338 that restricts the use of water during peak demand. Summarized below are the following restrictions applicable to residential and commercial properties serviced by the Riverhead Water District between Memorial Day and Labor Day:

1. Water customers with an address ending in an odd number shall water lawns, fill pools, wash cars, etc., only on odd numbered dates and vice versa for even numbers.
2. Water customers in subdivisions with common areas are restricted to watering common areas to every other day.
3. No watering is permitted, odd or even, between the hours of 5:00 a.m. & 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. & 9:00 p.m. The above restrictions shall take effect immediately.

Foxwood Management recommends that all lawn irrigation clocks be set to complete irrigation cycle between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. with even house numbers set to water on even days and vice versa.

**Businesses that remain closed - including Foxwood Village Clubhouse**

Despite entering Phase Four, many other types of businesses remain closed:

- Gyms, fitness centers and exercise classes, CrossFit gyms and other forms of personal training.
- Indoor theaters, including movie theaters and live production venues.
- Casinos, bingo games, off-track betting parlors, amusement arcades and game rooms.
- Bowling alleys, billiard parlors and pool halls.

Foxwood Village pool use is restricted to **Foxwood Village residents only**. No outside guests or relatives are permitted. This is to ensure the safety of ALL of our fellow residents. We apologize for the inconvenience and appreciate your cooperation.
