Cook's Corner

By Cathy Hannon

It is that time of year for some old traditional family recipes.

Ricotta Pie:

For crust:

3 cups all-purpose flour

Pinch of salt

1 teaspoon granulated sugar

1/2 teaspoon baking powder

1 egg, slightly beaten

2 tablespoon solid, white vegetable shortening, melted

2 tablespoons butter, melted

3 tablespoons milk

For the filling:

3 pounds whole milk ricotta cheese

12 eggs

1 1/2 cups granulated sugar

1 teaspoon fresh orange rind

1 teaspoon fresh lemon rind

Juice of 1 lemon

Juice of one orange

- 1. To make crust, combine flour, salt, sugar and baking powder in a bowl, stirring with a folk.
- 2. Make a well in the center of the dry ingredients.
- 3. Stir together egg, shortening and butter.
- 4. Pour mixture into the well and combine with a folk until mixture is crumbly. Add milk to make dough.
- 5. Gather mixture into a ball and set aside.
- 6. Cream together the ricotta, eggs, and sugar
- 7. Blend orange and lemon rinds and orange and lemon juices into the cheese mixture.
- 8. Roll dough out and fit into 2 10-inch pie pans. Divide filling between pans.
- 9. Roll out dough scraps and cut in strips. Arrange over filling in a crisscross diamond pattern.
- 10. Bake pies at 350 degrees for 1 hour. Remove from oven and completely cool.

Before serving, sprinkle with confectioners sugar.

Each pie 6 to 8 servings.

STUFFED BREAD:

1 pound pizza dough

1/4 pound salami, sliced or chopped

1/4 pound of ham sliced or chopped

1/4 pound pepperoni, sliced or chopped

8 ounces mozzarella cheese, shredded

1/4 teaspoon garlic powder

1 egg, beaten

- 1. Roll out pizza dough, layer with salami, ham, pepperoni and cheese.Roll from top to bottom...
- 2. Sprinkle with garlic powder and beaten egg.
- 3. Bake in 375 degree oven for 20 or 30 minutes.

Serves 6.

Note there are many variations of this. You may add 4 ounces ricotta cheese. A few hot pepper flakes, oregano or Parmesan cheese.
