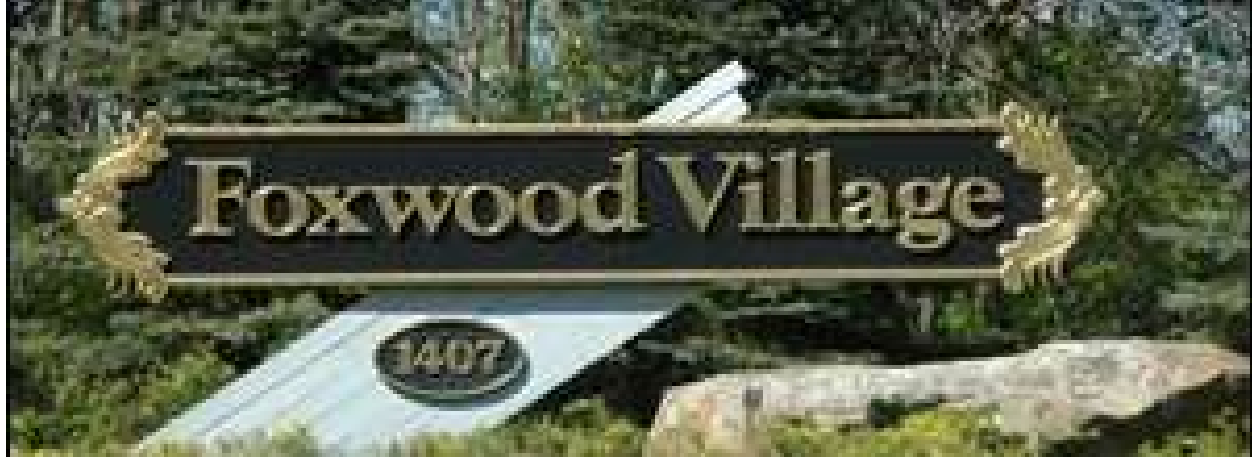

Cook's Corner

It is that time of year for some old traditional family recipes.

Ricotta Pie:

For crust:

3 cups all-purpose flour
Pinch of salt
1 teaspoon granulated sugar
1/2 teaspoon baking powder
1 egg , slightly beaten
2 tablespoon solid , white vegetable shortening, melted
2 tablespoons butter, melted
3 tablespoons milk

For the filling:

3 pounds whole milk ricotta cheese
12 eggs
1 1/2 cups granulated sugar
1 teaspoon fresh orange rind
1 teaspoon fresh lemon rind
Juice of 1 lemon
Juice of one orange

1. To make crust, combine flour, salt, sugar and baking powder in a bowl, stirring with a folk.
 2. Make a well in the center of the dry ingredients.
 3. Stir together egg, shortening and butter.
 4. Pour mixture into the well and combine with a folk until mixture is crumbly. Add milk to make dough.
 5. Gather mixture into a ball and set aside.
 6. Cream together the ricotta, eggs, and sugar
 7. Blend orange and lemon rinds and orange and lemon juices into the cheese mixture.
 8. Roll dough out and fit into 2 10-inch pie pans. Divide filling between pans.
 9. Roll out dough scraps and cut in strips. Arrange over filling in a crisscross diamond pattern.
 10. Bake pies at 350 degrees for 1 hour. Remove from oven and completely cool.
- Before serving , sprinkle with confectioners sugar.
Each pie 6 to 8 servings.

STUFFED BREAD:

1 pound pizza dough
1/4 pound salami, sliced or chopped
1/4 pound of ham sliced or chopped
1/4 pound pepperoni, sliced or chopped
8 ounces mozzarella cheese, shredded
1/4 teaspoon garlic powder
1 egg, beaten

1. Roll out pizza dough, layer with salami, ham, pepperoni and cheese. Roll from top to bottom..
2. Sprinkle with garlic powder and beaten egg.
3. Bake in 375 degree oven for 20 or 30 minutes.

Serves 6.

Note there are many variations of this. You may add 4 ounces ricotta cheese. A few hot pepper flakes, oregano or Parmesan cheese.
