Cook's Corner

The following is a quick and easy dish to prepare for Saint Patrick dinner. Skillet

Shepherd's Pie:

- Makes 6 servings.
- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 cup chopped onion
- 2 cups frozen corn, thawed
- 2 cups frozen peas, thawed
- 2 tablespoon ketchup
- 2 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 2 teaspoons minced garlic
- 1 tablespoon cornstarch 1 teaspoon bee bouillon

granules 1/2 cup cold water

1/2 cup sour cream

31/2 cups mashed potatoes (prepared with milk and butter) 3/4 cup shredded cheddar cheese.



In a large skillet, cook. beef and onions over medium heat until meat is no longer pink, drain. Stir in the corn, peas, ketchup, Worcestershire sauce and garlic. Reduce heat to medium-low; cover and cook for five minutes. 2. Combine the cornstarch, bouillon and water until well blended; stir into beef mixture. Bring to a boil over medium heat; cook and stir for 2 minutes or until thickened. Stir in sour cream and heat through (do not boil).
 Spread mashed potatoes over the top; sprinkle with cheese, cover and cook until potatoes are heated through and cheese is melted.

Place in a 350 degrees oven for around 15-20 minutes.

QUICK and EASY Irish Soda Bread:

- 3 1/2 cups sifted unbleached flour
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 2 teaspoon baking powder
- 2 eggs
- 1 pint sour cream
- 1 cup raisins
- 2 teaspoons caraway seeds (if wanted)
- 1. Mix dry ingredients
- 2. Fold in beaten eggs and sour cream.
- 3. Stir in raisins, caraway seeds.
- 4. Mold into a round loaf pan. Bake in a 350 degree oven for or until light brown on top.
