## Cook's Corner

By Catherine Hannon

The following is a quick and easy dish to prepare for Saint Patrick dinner. Skillet Shepherd's Pie:
Makes 6 servings.
1 pound ground beef
1 cup chopped onion
2 cups frozen corn, thawed
2 cups frozen peas, thawed
2 tablespoon ketchup
2 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
2 teaspoons minced garlic
1 tablespoon cornstarch 1 teaspoon bee bouillon granules $1 / 2$ cup cold water
$1 / 2$ cup sour cream


31/2 cups mashed potatoes (prepared with milk and butter) 3/4
cup shredded cheddar cheese.
1.In a large skillet, cook. beef and onions over medium heat until meat is no longer pink, drain. Stir in the corn, peas, ketchup, Worcestershire sauce and garlic. Reduce heat to medium-low; cover and cook for five minutes. 2. Combine the cornstarch, bouillon and water until well blended; stir into beef mixture. Bring to a boil over medium heat; cook and stir for 2 minutes or until thickened. Stir in sour cream and heat through (do not boil).
3. Spread mashed potatoes over the top; sprinkle with cheese, cover and cook until potatoes are heated through and cheese is melted.
Place in a 350 degrees oven for around 15-20 minutes.

QUICK and EASY Irish Soda Bread:
$31 / 2$ cups sifted unbleached flour
1/2 cup sugar
1 teaspoon salt
$1 / 2$ teaspoon baking soda
2 teaspoon baking powder
2 eggs
1 pint sour cream
1 cup raisins


2 teaspoons caraway seeds (if wanted)

1. Mix dry ingredients
2. Fold in beaten eggs and sour cream.
3. Stir in raisins, caraway seeds.
4. Mold into a round loaf pan. Bake in a 350 degree oven for or until light brown on top.
