

How to improve your internet speed for downloading to your wireless devices.

(Most homes have 3 or more wireless devices. Computer or laptop. Kindle or IPad. Cell Phone and YOUR TV)

Many of us are paying Optimum for high-speed internet. Optimum promises many of us 200MB speed. If you were to run a speed test; you would be amazed to find in many instances you are barely getting 35MB. That's far short of what you should get and what you might need to stream from all the services.

Many of you think this is unimportant. Why would I need faster speed? Well, I know many here use services like Netflix. Many have a fire stick for their TV. Streaming services like Hulu, Peacock, Amazon Prime, HBO Max and many others rely on the transfer of data from your Modem to your router. You might find that you cannot always download a movie or show as fast or get as many providers that you need.

Of course, our first to blame is optimum. The router isn't high speed or modem is bad. True there is always something to be said about a high-speed router. That's the ones you see with all the antennas. However, for most residents her, optimum's router is very good. So why don't I get the fastest speed. The simple answer is that silly yellow cable that came in the box from Optimum with the router.

The yellow cable that comes in the box is the standard cable. Like everything else we get new and better technology. Right now the best yellow cable out there is a Category 8. It si relatively cheap in a 3' length more than sufficient to go from your modem to the router unless you have some out rageous set up. It costs about \$8 on Amazon

https://www.amazon.com/gp/product/B082PHKT5H/ref=ppx_yo_dt_b_asin_title_o04_s00?ie=UTF8&psc=1 and I'm sure is available locally at Best Buy or PC Richards.

Before you invest, I recommend doing a speed test. You can run speed test by Okala https://www.speedtest.net/ and you can see if you are getting a worthwhile speed. If you change you should see a much-improved speed.

One final note. We all love wireless, me included but you must know that the maximum speed is hard to achieve unless your device is plugged into the router. That is why a simple upgrade of the cable can make the difference.

Tips For **SOUP SUCCESS**:

How to make it, serve it, share it, store it.

- *Shop smart and stock up on tomatoes ,beans, pasta ,broths and stocks.
- * Prep ingredients in advance and refrigerate them. Make the soup the day of the meal.
- * Use sturdy bowls or cups for serving and tasting.
- * Freeze soup in zip-top plastic freezer bags, they stack flat in the freezer.

Celebrate Easter with a good glazed ham.

Apricot Ginger Mustard-Glazed Ham.

Prep: 15 min. Bake: 2 hours. Makes 16 servings.

1 fully cooked bone-in ham(7 to 9 lbs.)

1/2 cup apricot halves, drained

1/2 cup stone-ground mustard

1/3 cup packed brown sugar

2Tbsp. Grated fresh ginger root

1 Tbsp. whole peppercorns

1/2 tsp. Sea salt

1/2 tsp. Coarsely ground pepper

- 1. Preheat oven to 325.Place ham on a rack in a shallow roasting pan. Using a sharp knife, score surface of ham with 14-in deep cuts in a diamond pattern. Cover and bake 1 3/4 a 2/1/4 hours or until thermometer reads 130. 2.meanwhile, Place the remaining ingredients in a food processor; process until blended. Remove ham from oven. Increase oven to 425. Spread apricot mixture over ham.
- 3. Bake ham, uncovered, for 15-20 minutes longer or until a thermometer reads 140. Turn the oven on broil 2-4 minutes until golden brown.

Passover Popovers

1/4tsp. Salt 1 cup matzo cake meal 7 eggs

1. Preheat oven to 450. Generously grease 12 Muffin cups. In a large saucepan, bring wAter, oil and salt to a rolling boil. Add cake meal all at once and beat until blended.Remove from heat; let stand 5 minutes. Place in oven. When puffed up and golden brown, they are ready to eat.
