## "WHAT'S FOR DINNER?'

Tomato-Feta Shrimp:
1 Tbsp olive oil
4cloves garlic, finely chopped 3 strips lemon zest, thinly sliced
1/2 12 oz jar salsa
18 oz can tomato sauce
20 large peeled shrimp and deveined 2cups baby spinach
1/4 cup crumbled feta cheese


Cooked orzo or flat bread, for serving

1. Heat oil in large skillet on medium, add garlic and lemon zest and cook until beginning to brown.
2. Add salsa and tomato sauce and bring to a simmer. Nestle shrimp in salsa mixture and cook covered,

## 3 minutes

3. Fold in spinach and cook until just beginning to wilt and shrimp are opaque throughout, 1-2 minutes more. Sprinkle with feta and serve with orzo or flatbread if desired.

## Serves 4.

If you want to make your own fresh salsa, it takes only 10 minutes.
2 jalapenos, finely chopped
1/2 small white onion, finely chopped
2 Tbsp fresh lime juice
Kosher salt

## Pepper

1 lb . plum tomatoes halved, seeded, and chopped 1/2 cup fresh cilantro chopped.


1. In a large bowl, toss all the above ingredients, except tomatoes. Let sit for 10 minutes.
2. Toss with tomatoes, then fold in cilantro.
