

IT'S PUMPKIN SEASON.

Enjoy the following alternative to pumpkin pie.

Great Pumpkin Dessert:

1 can (15oz)solid pack pumpkin

1 can(12 ounces) evaporated milk

3 large eggs

1 cup sugar

4 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice

1 package yellow cake mix(regular size)

3/4 cup butter, melted

11/2 cups chopped walnuts

Vanilla ice cream or whipped cream.

- 1. In a large bowl, beat the first five ingredients, until smooth.
- 2. Transfer to a greased 13x9-inch baking dish. Sprinkle with cake mix and drizzle with butter. Top with walnuts.
- 3.Bake at 350 for 1 hour or until a knife inserted near the center comes out clean. Serve with ice cream or whip cream.

Pumpkin-Lentil Soup:

3 cups water

3 cups reduced sodium chicken broth

2/3 cups dry lentils, rinsed

2 large garlic cloves, minced

1 tablespoon ground cumin

2 teaspoon dried oregano

1 can (15 ounces) pinto beans, rinsed and drained

1 can (15 ounces) blacked beans, rinsed and drained

1 can l(15 ounces) solid - packed pumpkin

1/2 cup mild salsa

1/2 teaspoon salt

5 cups fresh spinach, lightly packed.

- 1. In a 6 quart stockpot ,bring first six ingredients to a broil . Cook , covered, over medium heat until lentils are tender, 20-25 minutes.
- 2. Stir in beans, pumpkin, salsa, and salt until blended, return to boil. Reduce heat: simmer, uncover, 20 minutes, stirring occasionally. Stir in spinach, cook until wilted, 3-5 minutes. Serve with some hearty warm bread.

MUMMY WRAPPED BRIE

This baked brie appetizer is good enough to wake the dead.

1 package frozen puff pastry, thawed

1/2 cup apricot jam

1 round(16 ounces) Brie cheese

1 large egg

1 tablespoon water

Apple slices 2 dried cranberries or raisins.

1. Preheat oven to 400 degree. Unfold one sheet of puff pastry. On a lightly floured7 surface roll pastry into a 14- in. Square. Cut off corners to make a circle. Spread jam into a 41/2 - inch circle in center of pastry.

Place Brie on top: fold pastry over cheese, trimming as necessary and pinch edges to seal. Beat egg and water, brush over pastry.

2. Place on an ungreased baking sheet, seam side down. Roll remaining pastry into a 14- inch square. Cut four 1- inch strips, in half cross wise.wrap strips around Brie,trimming as necessary . Bake 10 minutes, brush again with egg wash. Bake until crust is golden brown , 10-15 minutes more. For eyes cut two circles from apple slices, place on top of Brie . Top each circle each with a dried cranberry.Serve warm .
