

COOK'S CORNER

It's Strawberry time! Take advantage of the season's berry best with some delicious ideas.

Strawberry Streusel Loaf Cake:

For streusel topping: 2 Tbsp unsalted butter 3Tbsp all-purpose flour 1Tbsp Demerara or turbinado sugar 1 Tbsp chopped roasted hazel nuts Make topping in bowl using fingertips Rub butter into flour, press in sugar and hazel nuts to make large clumps. Set aside.

For the Cake: $3/4 \operatorname{cup} (1 \ 1/2 \operatorname{cup} \operatorname{sticks})$ unsalted butter at room temp. 3/4 cup plus 3 Tbsp superfine sugar 2 large eggs 2 cups plus 3Tbsp self-rising flour4 tsp kosher salt Finely grated zest from 1 lemon 3 Tbsp milk

- 8 oz strawberries hulled and quartered
- 1. Heat oven to 350F. Lightly coat 81/2 by 4/2-in loaf pan nonstick spray and line with parchment

paper leaving overhang on 2 long sides.

2. Make cake using electric mixer, beat butter and sugar until light and fluffy.3min. Beat in eggs ,1 at a time be sure first is fully incorporated before adding next. Reduce speed and beat in flour, salt, and lemon zest until just combined (do not over mix) Beat in milk (batter will be thick).

3. Evenly spread one-third of batter into bottom of prepared pan. Scatter one-third of strawberries over batter. Repeat twice more, then scatter streusel on top. Bake until wooden pick inserted into center comes out clean.1 hour 10 min. Cool in pan 10 min. then using parchment overhangs, transfer loft to wire rack to completely cool.

4. Store in airtight container.

FRESH BERRY LEMONADE: Serves4. 2 cups Strawberry Simple Syrup 1/3 cups fresh lemon juice Sliced strawberries and lemons for serving. In pitcher stir together Syrup lemon juice and 5 cups ice cold water. Serve over ice with fruit.

Strawberry Simple Syrup: Makes about 2 cups. 1 lb strawberries hulled and sliced

1 cup sugar

1. In large saucepan, combine strawberries, sugar, and 2 cups water. Bring to boil. Stirring to dissolve sugar.

2.Reduce heat and simmer until berries turn pale and liquid is red, about 10 minutes. Skim off and discard any form that has risen to surface.

3. Let Syrup cool completely in sauce pan1 hour. Strain through fine mesh sieve and let cool. Discard berries or save for another use.

4. Refrigerate in airtight container up to 2 weeks.

****The Simple Syrup can be used for many other drinks.
