COOK'S CORNER

Catherine Hannon

Summer is a time for outdoor entertaining. Try the following dips.

Jalapeño popper dip:

Prep 10 min. Serves 8

1(8oz) pkg. cream cheese, softened1/3 cup mayonnaise1/3 cup sour cream1tsp. Garlic powder3 jalapeños, minced and divided3 cups shredded Colby jack cheese, divided

- 1. Combine cream cheese, mayonnaise, sour cream, garlic powder, 1/3 minced peppers and 2 cups colby jack cheese. Mix thoroughly and transfer to a cast iron pan. Top with remaining jalapeños and cheese.
- 2. Preheat grill to medium heat. Once brill is hot.place cast iron pan on brill and cook dip for 10-15 minutes.
- 3. Serve hot with veggies, crackers, chips, or bread for dipping.

Shrimp Dip:

Prep 10 minutes. Serves 8

1(12 oz) bag frozen large cooked peeled Shrimp; thawed, tails removed and roughly chopped

1(8oz) pkg. cream cheese, softened

1/3 cup sour cream

2 cups shredded Mexican style cheeses, divided

2 tsp. old Bay seasoning, divided

2 green onions, sliced and divided

- 1. Preheat grill to medium high heat.
- 2. Place shrimp, cream cheese, sour. cream, 1 cup cheese, 1 tsp. Old Bay seasoning and 1sliced green onion in a mixing bowl. Stir to combine.
- 3. Transfer mixture to a cast iron skillet.
- 4. Place skillet on hot grill close lid and allow cheese to melt
- 5. Top with remaining cheese, close lid and allow cheese to melt.
- 6. Once cheese has melted, remove the pan from the grill, top with remaining Old Bay seasoning and garnish with green onions.
- 7. Serve hot with crackers, bread, chips, or vegetables for dipping.
