

ENJOY THE FOLLOWING TREATS FOR YOUR HOLIDAY TABLE.

Cranberry Orange Scones:

1/2 cup flour

1 tablespoon plus 1 teaspoon sugar

1/2 teaspoon baking powder

1/8 teaspoon salt

3/4 teaspoon grated orange zest or 1/4 teaspoon pure orange extract

2 tablespoons unsalted chilled butter, diced

1/4 cup milk

1 tablespoon beaten egg

2 tablespoons dried cranberries

- 1. Preheat the oven to 375, shifting the rack to a middle upper setting if using a full size oven.
- 2. Combine the flour, sugar, baking powder, and salt in a medium mixing bowl; if using orange zest add as well.
- 3. Using a pastry cutter or fork, cut in the butter until it resembles coarse crumbs. Combine the milk and eggs. Stir into the dry ingredients along with the dried cranberries until the mixture holds together.
- 4. Scoop into two even mounds onto an ungreased baking sheet lined with parchment baking paper. If you wish brush the tops with a little beaten egg. Bake for about 25 minutes, until they are puffed, firm to touch, and light golden.



CINNAMON TOPPED BLUEBERRY MUFFINS:

Ingredients:

2 teaspoons butter, melted

2 tablespoons milk

1 tablespoon beaten egg

1/4 cup flour

1 tablespoon sugar+2 teaspoons

3/8 teaspoon baking powder

1/4 cup blueberries

Pinch of cinnamon

- 1. Preheat oven to 375, Combine the melted butter, milk, and egg in a small mixing bowl.
- 2. Add the flour, 1 tablespoon of sugar, salt, and baking powder, stirring together until just well blended. Gently stir in the blueberries. Divide the mixture evenly between 2 paper-lined muffin cups that have been stayed lightly with nonstick cooking spray.
- 3. For topping, combine the 2 teaspoons of sugar with the cinnamon and sprinkle evenly over the tops of the two muffins. Bake on a upper rack for approximately 20-25 minutes until the muffins are puffed, golden brown, and firm to touch.
- 4. Allow muffins to cool slightly before enjoying; the blueberries will be quite hot when first removed from the oven. These are best eaten fresh. The cinnamon sugar topping will soften with time.

GIANT BUTTER FLAKE BISCUITS:

Ingredients:

2/3 cup flour

1/4 teaspoon salt

11/2 teaspoons baking powder

2 teaspoons sugar

2 tablespoons plus 2 teaspoons cold butter

3/8 cup milk

- 1. In a small bowl, stir together the flour, salt, baking powder, and sugar.
- 2. Shred the very cold butter directly into the dry ingredients and toss lightly. Pour the cold milk over the mixture, stirring with a folk until it holds together.
- 3. Gather the dough together with your hands and pat it out and fold over 3/4 times on a Floured surface. Divide in half and lightly pat each half to about 1" thick, as close in size to the perimeters of your designated cutter as possible. Cut using a round cookie cutter. Cutting the edges allows the biscuit to rise more evenly, giving you a nice big biscuit.
- 4. Bake in a 375 oven for about 20 minutes, until light brown. Serve hot and with butter, jam, or honey.





What is a secure and protected website VS an unsecured and unprotected website

There has been some question about our website's unsecure status, and I want to address that issue. It is very important to understand this especially with all the online shopping we do and even more so around the Holidays.

See the padlock in corner next to the HTTPS: This denotes a secure and protected web site



No padlock before HTTP and words unsecure means an unsecure and unprotected site



Many antivirus programs will point out when you go to an unsecure and unprotected website. This does not mean the website will cause a virus in your computer. Your antivirus should BLOCK access to any such sites.

So, what is the difference. First to be a secure and protected site you purchase a certificate every year. That certificate then shows that you have taken steps to protect a customer's secure information like social security numbers or bank numbers. and financial records like credit cards. The HTTP(S) for secure.

Secure sites use encrypted information and unsecure use plain text

Foxwood web site does not have a certificate because the high cost is not worth the expense because we neither receive nor take personal information from our residents or financial information. We are strictly an community information generating site. The HTTP (no s)

As such our site is safe and secure for all to use.

Regarding anti-virus: we do have a very secure Firewall that we pay for that protects the information we generate on our site.

The answer to the question is our site Safe to use? YES it is.

IN SUMMATION

You can look, read and get ideas from a website marked unsecure and unprotected like Our Foxwood Site because it is a known site to you. Never, Ever give to a site marked <u>unsecure or unprotected</u> any personal information or credit card information.


If you come upon unsecure or unprotected sites on the web you are NOT familiar with, if possible, avoid it. You usually can find what you are looking for on another secure site.
