# COOK'S CORNER

Catherine Hannon



Welcome to the Year of the RABBIT.

If you're looking for vegetarian meal options, tofu is a beneficial ingredient to incorporate into your diet. The Asian inspired noodle dish below calls for extra firm tofu.

TOFU & PEANUT NOODLES.

Makes 4 servings.

Cook 8 oz. Dry multigrain spaghetti or vermicelli

2 tsp. Toasted sesame oil

Heat 1 tablespoon canola oil

8 oz. Extra firm tofu, patted dry, cut into cubes

1 cup sliced red bell peppers

1 Tbsp. each minced fresh ginger and shallots

1/2 cup bias sliced scallions

Stir in 1/4 cup low sodium soy sauce

3 Tbsp. Chunky peanut butter

2 Tbsp. Rice vinegar

1 Tbsp. Chili garlic sauce

Cook spaghetti in a large pot of boiling water according to package directions. Reserve1/4 cup pasta water, then drain spaghetti ad transfer to a large bowl.; add

Sesame oil and toss to coat. Heat canola oil over medium high in a nonstick skillet. Add tofu and sauté until lightly browned, about 2 minutes per side. Add bell peppers, ginger, and shallots to skillet, until bell peppers soften, 2-3 minutes.

Stir in soy sauce, peanut, rice vinegar, and chili garlic sauce until incorporated; cook 1 minute.

Serve tofu mixture over pasta and garnish with scallions.

### ASIAN SPINACH SALAD:

A simple salad of vegetables and a light Asian vinaigrette complements the noodle dish.

Makes 4 servings.

3 Tbsp. Rice vinegar

2 Tbsp. Canola oil

1 tsp. Sugar

1 tsp. Dijon mustard

1/2 tsp. Kosher salt

1/4 tsp. Chili garlic sauce

4 cup fresh spinach

1/2 cup each sliced cucumber and radish

Black pepper to taste

Whisk together vinegar, oil sugar, Dijon, salt and chili garlic sauce for the vinaigrette.

Combine spinach, cucumber, and radish in a large bowl; toss with vinaigrette and season with pepper.
